

Preparation & Storage

Storage	Store at -20°C Valid for 12 months. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles.
Shipping	The product is shipped with ice pack, upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended.

Background

C9orf116, also known as PIERCE1. PIERCE1 is an important p53 target gene contributing to normal DNA damage response and may play crucial roles in maintaining genomic integrity against genotoxic stresses, including UVC irradiation. PIERCE1 exists as two alternatively spliced isoforms and is predominantly expressed in human small cell lung cancer. PIERCE1 knockdown induces down-regulation of proapoptotic genes including Ei24, Apaf1 and PTEN, suggesting that PIERCE1 is a proapoptotic gene. It is helpful for in-depth understanding of p53 pathways and the design of new cancer therapies.

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
