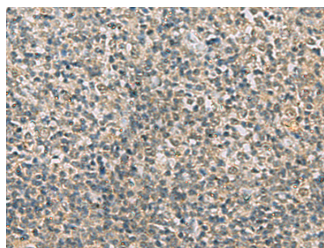

Background

RAB3IP (RAB3A Interacting Protein) is a Protein Coding gene. Among its related pathways are Organelle biogenesis and maintenance and Vesicle-mediated transport. Gene Ontology (GO) annotations related to this gene include Rab guanyl-nucleotide exchange factor activity. An important paralog of this gene is RAB3IL1.
