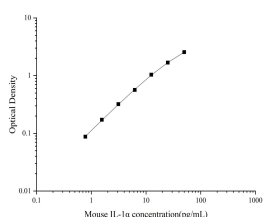

Sandwich ELISA-Recombinant Mouse IL-1 $\alpha$ /IL-1F1 protein standard curve. Background subtracted standard curve using IL-1 $\alpha$ /IL-1F1 antibody(AN000760P)(Capture), IL-1 $\alpha$ /IL-1F1 Antibody(AN001820P)(Detector) in sandwich ELISA. The reference range value for Recombinant Mouse IL-1 $\alpha$ /IL-1F1 protein is 0.78-50 pg/mL.

### Preparation & Storage

<b>Storage</b>	Store at 4°C valid for 12 months or -20°C valid for long term storage, avoid freeze / thaw cycles.
<b>Shipping</b>	The product is shipped with ice pack, upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended.

### Background

Produced by activated macrophages, IL-1 stimulates thymocyte proliferation by inducing IL-2 release, B-cell maturation and proliferation, and fibroblast growth factor activity. IL-1 proteins are involved in the inflammatory response, being identified as endogenous pyrogens, and are reported to stimulate the release of prostaglandin and collagenase from synovial cells.
