

## Background

MAPK14(mitogen-activated protein kinase 14) is also named as SAPK2A,p38MAPK,CSBP1,RK,p38,EXIP,Mxi2,CSBP2, PRKM14,PRKM15,CSPB1,p38ALPHA and belongs to the MAP kinase subfamily. MAPK14-signaling is a central pathway for the integration of instructive signals in dendritic cells for T(H)17 differentiation and inflammation. It plays an important role in the regulation of hematopoietic stem cellself-renewal in vitro and inhibition of MAPK14 activation with a small molecule inhibitor may represent a novel approach to promote ex vivo expansion of hematopoietic stem cell. This protein has 4 isoforms produced by alternative splicing.
