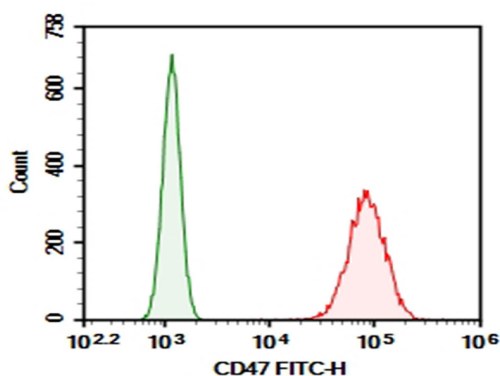

<b>Isotype</b>	Mouse IgG1, κ
<b>Clone</b>	B6H12
<b>Purification</b>	>98%, Protein A/G purified
<b>Conjugation</b>	Unconjugated
<b>Buffer</b>	Phosphate-buffered solution, pH 7.2, containing 0.05% non-protein stabilizer. Dialyze to completely remove the stabilizer prior to labeling.

### Preparation & Storage

<b>Storage</b>	Store at 4°C valid for 12 months or -20°C valid for long term storage, avoid freeze / thaw cycles.
<b>Shipping</b>	Ice bag

### Background

CD47 (also integrin-associated protein/IAP and OA3) is a variably glycosylated, 40-60 kDa atypical member of the Ig-Superfamily. It is expressed on almost all cell types, including erythrocytes. CD47 binds to TSP-1 and SIRP alpha, and forms a membrane complex with CD36 and alpha v beta 3. Mature human CD47 is a 305 amino acid (aa), five-transmembrane glycoprotein.
