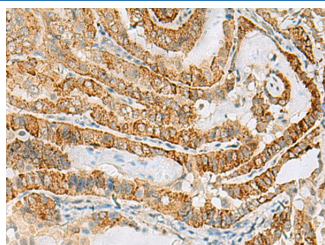
### Description

<b>Buffer</b>	Phosphate buffered solution, pH 7.4, containing 0.05% stabilizer and 50% glycerol.

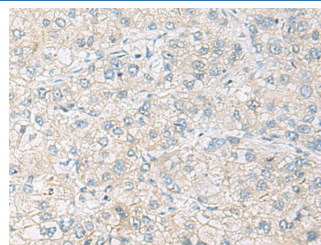

### Preparation & Storage

<b>Storage</b>	Store at -20°C Valid for 12 months. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles.
<b>Shipping</b>	The product is shipped with ice pack, upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended.

### Background

FARP2 (FERM, ARH/RhoGEF And Pleckstrin Domain Protein 2) is a Protein Coding gene. Diseases associated with FARP2 include Pseudohypoparathyroidism Ia and Aarskog-Scott Syndrome. Among its related pathways are Development Endothelin-1/EDNRA signaling and Focal Adhesion. GO annotations related to this gene include Rho guanyl-nucleotide exchange factor activity and Rac guanyl-nucleotide exchange factor activity. An important paralog of this gene is FARP1.

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
