## Background

Tumor Necrosis Factor  $\beta$  (TNF- $\beta$ ) is a secreted protein belonging to the tumor necrosis factor family. TNF- $\beta$  binds to TNFRSF1A/TNFR1, TNFRSF1B/TNFBR and TNFRSF14/HVEM in homotrimeric form, binds to TNFRSF3/LTBR in heterotrimeric form with LTB. TNF- $\beta$  forms heterotrimers with lymphotoxin-beta, which anchors TNF- $\beta$  to the cell surfac e. TNF- $\beta$  mediates the inflammatory, immunostimulatory, and antiviral response, involves in the formation of second lymphoid organs during development, has a role in apoptosis. TNF- $\beta$  is produced by lymphocytes and cytotoxic for a variety of tumor cells in vitro and in vivo.
