

Background

The green fluorescent protein (GFP) is a protein that exhibits bright green fluorescence when exposed to light in the blue to ultraviolet range. It is first isolated from the jelly fish Aequorea victoria and is frequently used as a reporter of expression. GFP is widely used in gene expression, tracing and protein subcellual localization.

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
