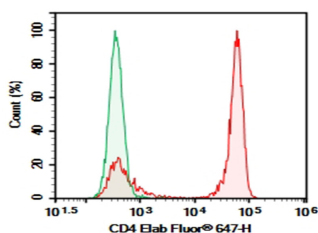
Reactivity	Rat
Host	Mouse
Isotype	Mouse IgG2a, κ
Clone	OX-38
Buffer	Phosphate-buffered solution, pH 7.2, containing 0.05% non-protein stabilizer. Dialyze to completely remove the stabilizer prior to labeling.

FCM ≤ 0.2 µg per million cells in 100 µL volume

Rat splenocytes were stained with 0.2 µg Purified Anti-Rat CD4(domain 1) Antibody[OX-38] (Right) and 0.2 µg Mouse IgG2a, κ Isotype Control (Left), followed by FITC-conjugated Goat Anti-Mouse IgG Secondary Antibody.

Preparation & Storage

Storage	Store at 4°C valid for 12 months or -20°C valid for long term storage, avoid freeze / thaw cycles.
Shipping	Ice bag

Background

CD4, also known as T4, is a 55kD glycoprotein member of the immunoglobulin superfamily and is expressed on majority of thymocytes, macrophages, and a peripheral T cell subset (T helper cells). CD4 is a T cell co-receptor that interacts with the MHC class II molecule and is involved in T cell activation.

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
