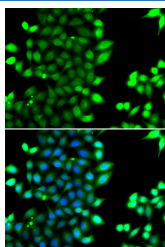

Preparation & Storage

Storage	Store at -20°C Valid for 12 months. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles.
Shipping	The product is shipped with ice pack, upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended.

Background

The protein encoded by this gene is a highly conserved ring finger protein. It is an essential subunit of SKP1-cullin/ CDC53-F box protein ubiquitin ligases, which are a part of the protein degradation machinery important for cell cycle progression and signal transduction. This protein interacts with, and is a substrate of, casein kinase II (CSNK2A1/CKII).

The phosphorylation of this protein by CSNK2A1 has been shown to promote the degradation of IκappaBα (CHUK/IKK-α/IKBKA) and p27Kip1 (CDKN1B). Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding distinct isoforms have been reported.

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
