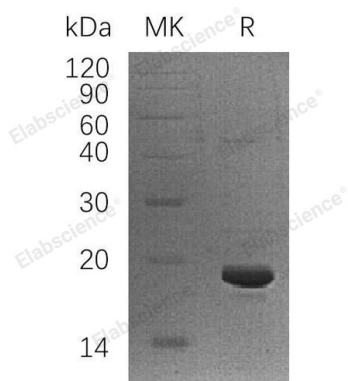

<b>Species</b>	Human

## Properties

<b>Purity</b>	> 90 % as determined by reducing SDS-PAGE.
<b>Endotoxin</b>	< 1.0 EU per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
<b>Storage</b>	Generally, lyophilized proteins are stable for up to 12 months when stored at -20 to -80 °C. Reconstituted protein solution can be stored at 4-8°C for 2-7 days. Aliquots of reconstituted samples are stable at < -20°C for 3 months.
<b>Shipping</b>	This product is provided as lyophilized powder which is shipped with ice packs.
<b>Formulation</b>	Lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered solution of 20mM PB, 150mM NaCl, pH 7.2. Normally 5% - 8% trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween 80 are added as protectants before lyophilization.

## Background

U6 snRNA-Associated Sm-Like Protein LSml (LSM1) belongs to the snRNP Sm proteins family. The Sm-like proteins are thought to form a stable heteromer present in tri-snRNP particles, which plays an important role in pre-mRNA splicing. LSM1 binds specifically to the 3-terminal U-tract of U6snRNA. LSM1 can interact with SLBP when histone mRNA is being rapidly degraded during the S phase. In addition, LSM1 is associated with cellular transformation and the progression of several malignancies including mesothelioma, lung cancer and breast cancer.
