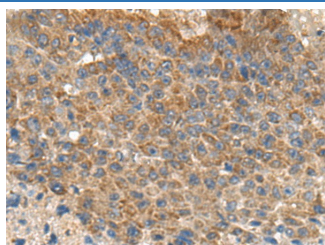

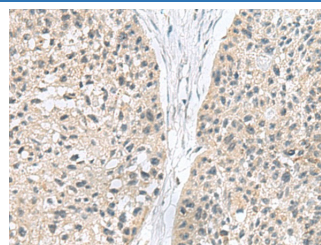

Preparation & Storage

Storage	Store at -20°C Valid for 12 months. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles.
Shipping	The product is shipped with ice pack, upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended.

Background

MIA (Melanoma Inhibitory Activity) is a Protein Coding gene. Diseases associated with MIA include Melanoma and Skin Melanoma. Among its related pathways are Neural Crest Differentiation. GO annotations related to this gene include growth factor activity. An important paralog of this gene is MIA-RAB4B.

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
