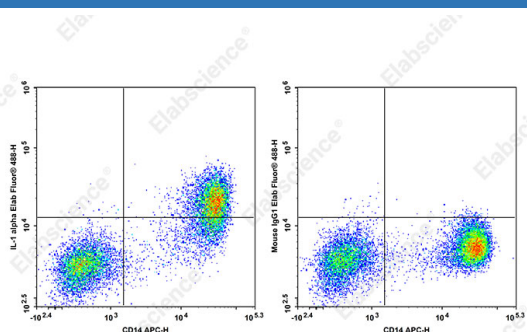

Background

IL-1 refers to two proteins, IL-1 α and IL-1 β which are the products of distinct genes, but which are recognized by the same cell surface receptors. IL-1 α is a potent immunomodulator which mediates a wide range of immune and inflammatory responses. The 364-3B3-14 antibody reacts with human interleukin-1 α (IL-1 α). The 364-3B3-14 antibody is a non-neutralizing antibody.
