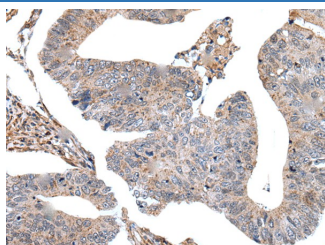

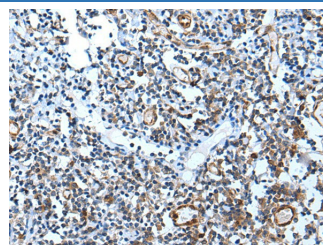

Preparation & Storage

Storage	Store at -20°C Valid for 12 months. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles.
Shipping	The product is shipped with ice pack, upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended.

Background

USP37 (ubiquitin specific peptidase 37) is a 979 amino acid protein that contains three UIM (ubiquitin-interacting motif) repeats and belongs to the peptidase C19 family. Expressed in prostate and brain tissue, USP37 functions to catalyze the conversion of a ubiquitin C-terminal thioester to a free ubiquitin and a thiol. The gene encoding USP37 maps to human chromosome 2, which houses over 1,400 genes and comprises nearly 8% of the human genome.
