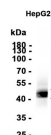

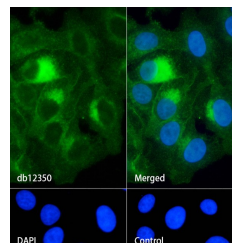

Immunofluorescence analysis of HepG2 cells labelling CAR.

The cells were fixed with 4% PFA (10min, RT) followed by treatment with 0.1% Triton X-100 (10min, RT), and blocked in 1% BSA/10% normal goat serum/0.3M glycine in 0.1% PBS-Tween 20 for 1h. The cells were then incubate (1:500) at room temprature for 1h, followed by a further incubation at room temprature for 45min with Goat Anti Rabbit IgG (H+L)-AF488 (shown in green). Nuclear DNA was labeled in blue with DAPI. Control: Secondary antibody only.

| The protein encoded by this gene is a type I membrane receptor for group B coxsackieviruses and subgroup C adenoviruses. Several transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene. Pseudogenes of this gene are found on chromosomes 15, 18, and 21. [provided by RefSeq, May 2011] |

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
