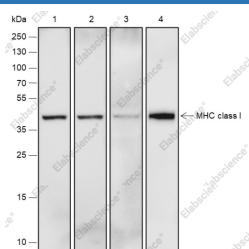

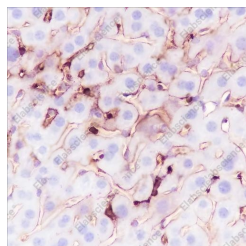

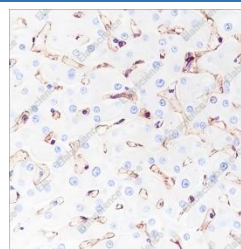

Observed-MW:40 kDa

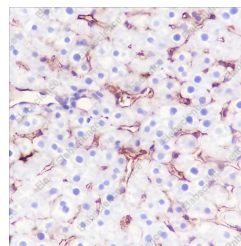
Calculated-MW:41 kDa

Antigen-presenting major histocompatibility complex class I (MHC I) molecule. In complex with B2M/beta 2 microglobulin displays primarily viral and tumor-derived peptides on antigen-presenting cells for recognition by T cell receptor (TCR) on MHC I -restricted CD8-positive T cells, guiding antigen-specific T cell immune response to eliminate infected or transformed cells.
