

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#### **Background**

CD49d is a 150 kD  $\alpha$  integrin chain known as  $\alpha4$  integrin or VLA-4  $\alpha$  chain. It forms a heterodimer with either integrin  $\beta1$  ( $\alpha4\beta1$ , VLA-4) or  $\beta7$  ( $\alpha4\beta7$ ). CD49d is expressed broadly on T lymphocytes, B lymphocytes, monocytes, thymocytes, eosinophils, basophils, mast cells, NK cells, dendritic cells, and some non-hematopoietic cells, but not on normal red blood cells, platelets or neutrophils. VLA-4 binds to VCAM-1 (CD106) and fibronectin.  $\alpha4\beta7$  is the receptor for VCAM-1 and MAdCAM-1. CD49d participates in mononuclear cell trafficking to endothelial sites of inflammation and has roles in cell-cell interactions and cell adhesion to extracellular matrices. CD49d is involved in lymphocyte migration, T cell activation, and hematopoietic stem cell differentiation. CD49d is a marker to isolate pure populations of Treg cells due to its absence on Foxp3+ cells.
