

Background

CD8b is the 32 kD β chain of CD8, also known as Lyt-3 or Ly-3. It is a member of the Ig superfamily expressed as a heterodimer with the CD8 α chain on a subset of MHC class I-restricted T cells and most thymocytes. CD8 is a coreceptor for the TCR complex involved in T cell activation.
