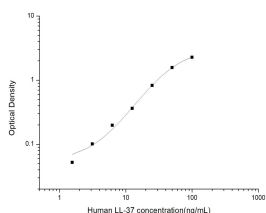

Background subtracted standard curve using CAMP/LL37/FALL39 antibody(AN002000P)(Capture), CAMP/LL37/FALL39 antibody(AN002010P)(Detector) in sandwich ELISA. The reference range value for Recombinant Human CAMP/LL37/FALL39 protein is 1.56-100 ng/mL.

## Preparation & Storage

<b>Storage</b>	Store at 4°C valid for 12 months or -20°C valid for long term storage, avoid freeze / thaw cycles.
<b>Shipping</b>	The product is shipped with ice pack, upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended.

## Background

This gene encodes a member of an antimicrobial peptide family, characterized by a highly conserved N-terminal signal peptide containing a cathelin domain and a structurally variable cationic antimicrobial peptide, which is produced by extracellular proteolysis from the C-terminus. In addition to its antibacterial, antifungal, and antiviral activities, the encoded protein functions in cell chemotaxis, immune mediator induction, and inflammatory response regulation.
